

Willamette Valley Vineyards winery tasting room, restaurant coming to the Waterfront Vancouver

A new winery tasting room and full-service restaurant, Willamette Valley Vineyards, is coming to the Waterfront Vancouver.

The winery will be located in The Don building, the western of the two Waterfront Vancouver buildings nearest the Grant Street Pier. It will be on the second story, near Barlow's Public House, and offer patio dining with a view of the river.

The new location is part of a four-location expansion from [Willamette Valley Vineyards](#), headquartered in Turner, Ore. The Winery is a publicly traded company, trading under the symbol WVI on the NASDAQ.

“All will have full dining service to complement the tasting of our wines, providing Owners and Wine Club Members a convenient place to entertain their family and friends,” according to a company newsletter.

Other locations include Lake Oswego, Bend and Happy Valley, although the exact addresses are not yet available. The first of the four is expected to open late this year, according to a statement from the company, although it didn’t clarify which one. The winery restaurants will build on the company’s prototype in Folsom, Calif., according to the newsletter.
